Dates – Friday, January 15, 2010 – Tuesday, January 19, 2010

Performance – Monday, January 18, 2010: Directed by Dr. Timothy Sharp at Carnegie Hall

Cost: \$1700.00 – this cost includes airfare through Tzell Travel. We will offer fundraising opportunities throughout the year. Each participating student will earn 50% of the **Profit** that will be put in an individual student account. This money can only be used for trip related expenses.

Payments: *The following payment schedule must be closely adhered to. Payments have to be made to the travel company to ensure our ability to go on the trip.*

*The first two payments of \$200 each should have been paid at this time.
If you have not paid this please do so as soon as possible.*

3rd Payment - \$300 due 9/1
4th Payment - \$300 due 10/1
Final Payment - \$700 due 11/2

Cancellation:

Cancellations are no longer allowed, the entire amount for the trip will be charged for students who have committed to the trip.

FACTS:

- Four nights lodging at a four-star hotel based on quad occupancy (NOTE: There is a surcharge for students **requesting** less than four to a room. SINGLE - \$1049.00, DOUBLE – \$442.00, TRIPLE – \$220.00 per person)
- Included in the cost is a post-concert celebration reception cruise. It will be a two-hour sail featuring a spectacular view of the Statue of Liberty and the Manhattan skyline, with a buffet supper, music, and dancing.
- All non-performers (chaperones) will receive a complimentary ticket to the concert in addition to all other package items.
- All rehearsal and concert related bus transportation within the city of New York are included.
- Also included in all packages is an entrance coupon ticket to the observation deck of the Empire State Building, a replica of the Carnegie Hall poster, an on-stage photograph of the ensemble's performance, a gift coupon for Macy's in New York, and a coupon for Bloom's Deli and other restaurants in Manhattan.
